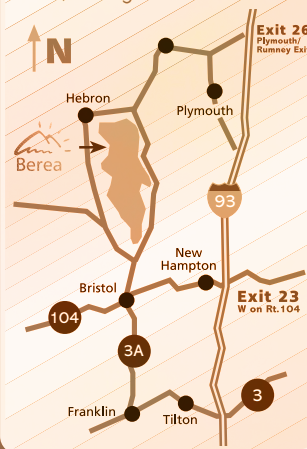
aBOUt aNdY
